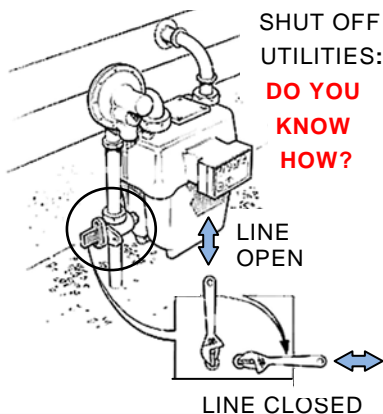


Calling All Beaverton Hispanic Community Members!
